paid in full April 15

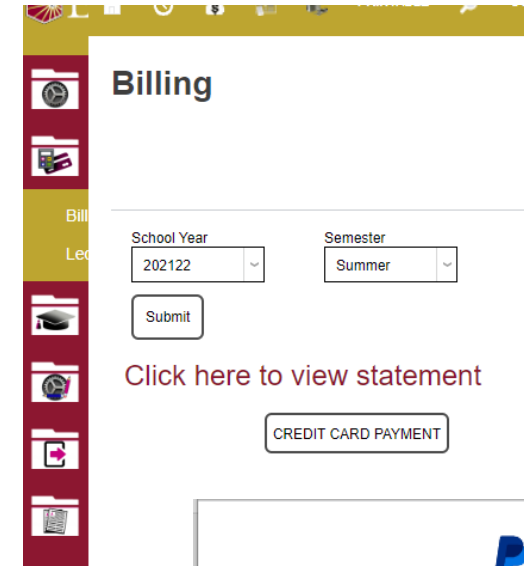
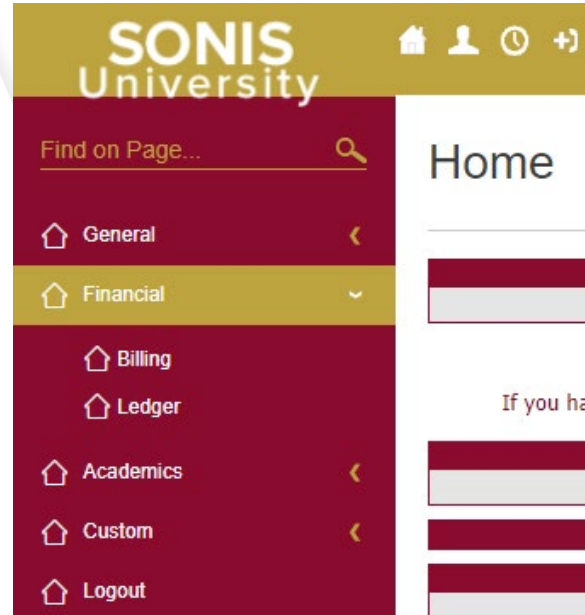

Mandatory Insurance



All students must have personal health insurance coverage per Department of Education regulations. Cost for the academic year will be approximately \$2,325 which covers you from August 1-July 31.



Waiving coverage must be complete prior to 10th day of class!



You will need your insurance information to complete the waiver form.



Please contact the Business Office if you have any difficulty.



***NOTE:** If a student does not 'waive coverage' of the college health insurance, they will be automatically enrolled and charged the cost of the college health insurance (\$2,325). This charge will show on their bill.

Athletic Insurance



Per NCAA regulations, student athletes are required to have additional athletic health insurance on top of their personal health insurance



Student athletes in multiple sports are only charged once


Estimated Fees charged in the semester the activity occurs

Financial Aid Checklist Items

- ☐ Complete a FAFSA® for this current year
- ☐ Log into your EC financial aid portal to review your financial aid offers.
<https://www.eureka.edu/current-students/resources>
- ☐ If your offer includes federal student loans, you the student must take action on your portal by either “accept” or “decline” your loan offer.
- ☐ If you “accept” loans, you the student must complete both the loan ‘Entrance Counseling’ & ‘Promissory Note (MPN)’ at studentaid.gov
- ☐ Plan for your yearly estimated out of pocket cost not covered by your financial aid.

Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®)

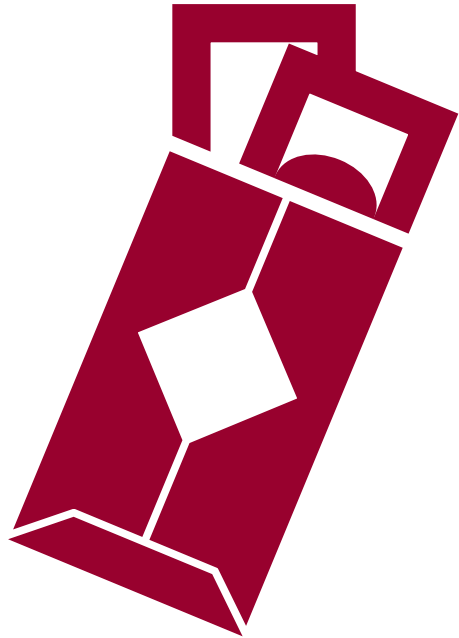
- MARK your calendar to renew your FAFSA® for the next academic year. New FAFSA® simplification coming!
- Filing a FAFSA® is needed in order to be considered for state & federal aid each year.

Your Financial Aid Offer

- Log into your EC financial aid student portal to view your offers. <https://www.eureka.edu/current-students/resources>
- Your financial aid offers are an *estimate* and subject to change if new information becomes available such as, but not limited to, change in your FAFSA® information; enrollment status; residency status; and/or Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) not met.
- As a new student, you received an email notification of your offers.
- Your Financial Aid Offer Email is not a bill and is an *estimate*. It is an email notification provided to students & families as an *estimate* of direct charges & financial aid offers in addition to an *estimate* of their *net cost (out-of-pocket due)*.





Types of Financial Aid

- Gift Aid - scholarships & grants (no repayment).
- Borrowed Aid - loans (repayment required)
- Earned Aid - student employment (based on earnings)

Q & A to Test Your Knowledge

1) Where do I find my EC Financial Aid Student Portal?

Answer: www.eureka.edu/current-students/resources

2) How do I accept or decline the Federal Student Loans?

Answer: Log into your Financial Aid Student Portal.

3) Do I have to file a **FAFSA**® ?

Answer: No! If you do not file a FAFSA®, you can not use Federal Student Aid including Loans and Pell Grants.

4) Why is my billing statement different from the Financial Aid Offer?

Answer: Your Financial Aid Offer is ONLY an Estimate. Your billing statement has actual charges
