How Does it Work?

The **Cybersecurity Certificate** is comprised of **480 hours** of best-in-class content and hands-on learning. Below are the course options available in 2024.

Online with Virtual Class Meetings: Start Dates are February 5 and August 19, 2024. Classes meet online via Zoom on Mondays and Thursdays, from 5-9 pm CST. There are deadlines for assignments throughout the 6-month program.

Fully Remote: There will be 9 start dates throughout 2024. There are no virtual class meetings, instead, you will have 6-months to work through the course content and hands-on training. You will have 1 hour each week where you can meet with a facilitator for a Q&A session.

* One month before the start date, students will gain access to a 30-hour Introduction to Cybersecurity required pre-work assignment that is due before the class begins.
