\$3,000 1st year (2.5 to renew, \$2,000 2nd year)

Presidential Scholarship:

\$5,000 (3.25 to renew)

Dean's Scholarship:

\$4,000 (2.75 to renew)

\$3,000 (2.0 to renew)

Phi Theta Kappa Honor Award: Phi Theta Kappa member and at least 24 transferable semester hours.

May be combined with Walnut Grove, Nu Tau Epsilon or Ivy Grant Scholarships.

\$2,000 (3.25 – renewable one year)

Walnut Grove Scholarship: 3.5 and up transferable GPA in at least 24 semester hours.

\$4,000 (3.25 to renew)

Nu Tau Epsilon Scholarship: 3.0 and up transferable GPA in at least 24 semester hours.

\$3,000 (2.75 to renew)

Ivy Grant: 2.0 and up transferable GPA in at least 24 semester hours.

\$2,000 (2.0 to renew)
