



SPECIAL EDUCATION Approval Program offered as Continuing Education Credit at Eureka College

Eureka College offers courses that will qualify certified teachers for a Special Education Approval by the State Board of Education. The approval could be earned by completing a sequence of three graduate level courses. Teachers can earn an LBSI endorsement by passing the state LBSI certification test.

Individuals **must** hold a bachelor's degree with teacher certification, and are looking for an endorsement in Special Education or Continuing Education credit.

Classes are offered on a rotating basis and can be completed within a year's time. One course is offered each semester—Spring, Summer, Fall.

Special Education Teacher Approval Model

- 3 courses in Special Education = 10 semester credit hours
- 1 Field Experience = 1 semester credit hour
- Classes are taught Thursday nights on the Eureka College Campus (summer schedule is Tuesday & Thursday nights)
- Cohort number limited, deposit early to reserve your classes
- Program cost of \$4,120 covers all tuition, books & materials
