## A Guide to Course Numbering

Please consider the following as you make your selections:

100-LEVEL COURSES are typically introductory and appropriate for fulfilling general requirements.

200-LEVEL COURSES are typically intermediate in the level and may or may not assume previous introduction to the discipline studied.

300-LEVEL COURSES typically represent an advanced and rigorous level of study, and therefore students normally should have completed courses at the intermediate level.

400-LEVEL COURSES are normally reserved for seniors and represent "capstone" courses in a major.
