## Mandatory Insurance

- All students must have personal health insurance coverage per
  Department of Education regulations. Cost for the academic year will be
  approximately \$2,250 which covers you from August 1-July 31.
- To purchase OR waive coverage, please visit: <a href="www.firststudent.com">www.firststudent.com</a>
  Waiving coverage must be complete prior to 10<sup>th</sup> day of class!
- You will need your insurance information to complete the waiver form.
- Please contact the Business Office if you have any difficulty.
- \*NOTE: If a student does not 'waive coverage' of the college health insurance, they will be automatically enrolled and charged the cost of the college health insurance (\$2,250). This charge will show on their bill.



## Athletic Insurance

- Per NCAA regulations, student athletes are required to have additional athletic health insurance on top of their personal health insurance
- Students athletes in multiple sports are only charged once

## **Payment Options**

Any balance left after all financial aid and loans have been applied will be paid in one of the following ways. All student accounts are expected to be paid in full in the semester they are incurred with the exception of enrolling in Nelnet.

- Pay in Full Fall due date of August 15<sup>th</sup>; Spring due date of January 15th
- Two Equal Payments Fall semester due dates of August 15<sup>th</sup> & October 1<sup>st</sup>; Spring semester due dates of January 15<sup>th</sup> & March 1<sup>st</sup>
- Monthly Payment Plan through Nelnet Campus Commerce-

Eureka College will send out an email inviting you to enroll in a payment plan, check your student EC email.

In the email invite select set up a payment plan

Sign in or create a username and password

LAST payment due on April 15<sup>th</sup>, this should have paid your account in full

FAMILIES set up the budget. It is your responsibility to adjust the budget up or down if there is a change in the student's bill





### **Payment Methods**

- Automatic bank payment (ACH)
- Credit card/debit card (an additional fee will be assessed)

Note: Payments are processed automatically on the 15th of each month

#### Cost to participate

- \$85 enrollment fee for annual payment plans
- \$57 enrollment fee for semester payment plans
- \$30 returned payment fee

# Other Payment Options To Consider –

These arrangements are to be made prior to due dates in order to avoid late fees.

- 529 Plan/ College Illinois If you have a savings plan please contact College Illinois to begin the process of withdrawals. 529 Plan holders will work with their servicer to request payment to Eureka College. Families using either plan are asked to contact <a href="mailto:businessoffice@eureka.edu">businessoffice@eureka.edu</a> so we can make appropriate notations on student accounts. Please note for 529 Plans, payments are expected by the prescribed due dates each semester.

# Campus Employment

- Student worker positions available
  - Available positions are emailed to all students
  - Directions on how to apply are in the email
  - Student workers will need government IDs to start working; be sure your student has a valid state photo id and social security card OR a valid passport for employment purposes
- How do I use my 'federal work study offer'?
  - Your financial aid offer of 'federal work study' is indicated on your award letter, you will need
    to go through the same process of applying for employment and getting hired. Federal Work
    Study applications will be considered first for a position. The earned aid of 'federal work
    study' is paid directly to the student based on hours worked of a campus job. Earnings are
    not automatically deducted from charges.
