## How to download Canvas Mobile App for Students (Android & Apple)

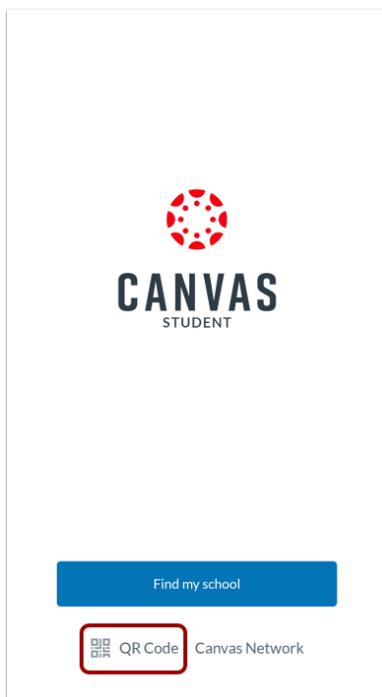
### How to for Android Phone

Once you download the Canvas Student app from the Play store, you can use the app to log in to your Canvas account.

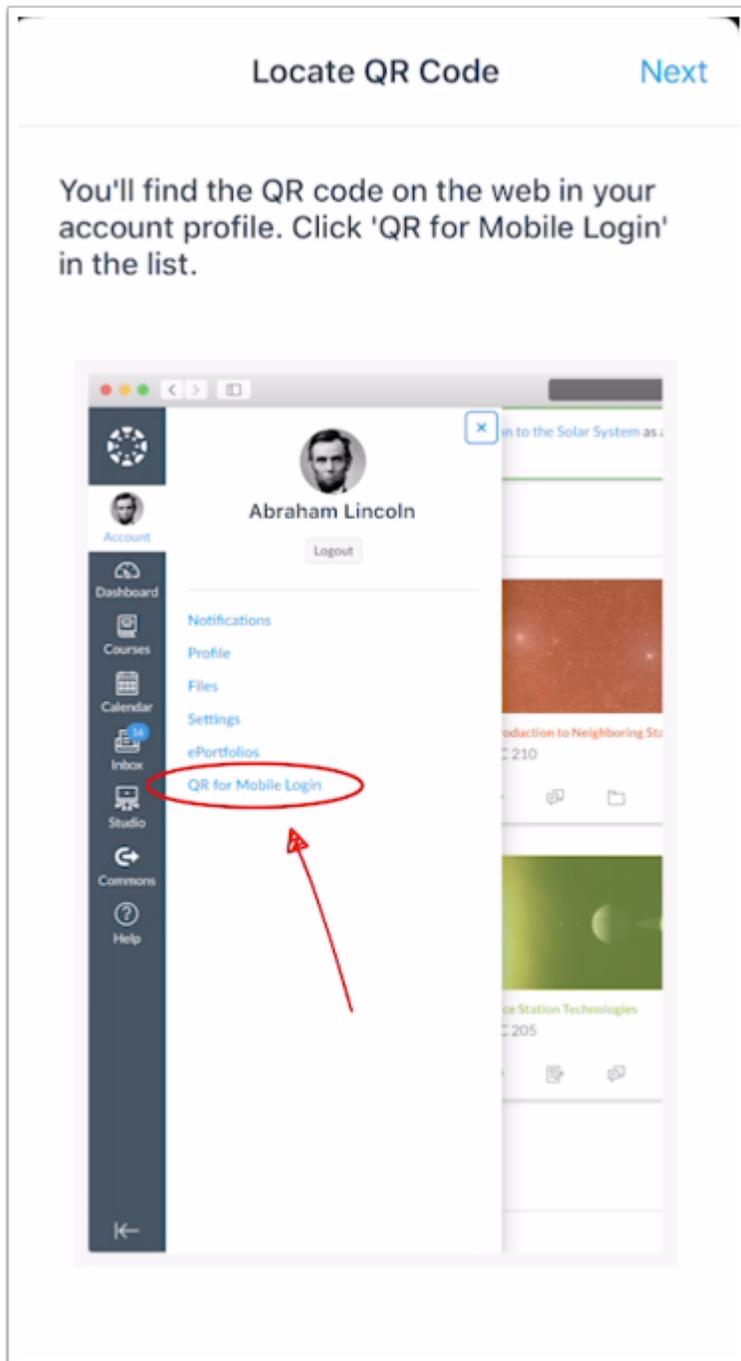
1. Open your Android device and tap the **Canvas Student** icon.



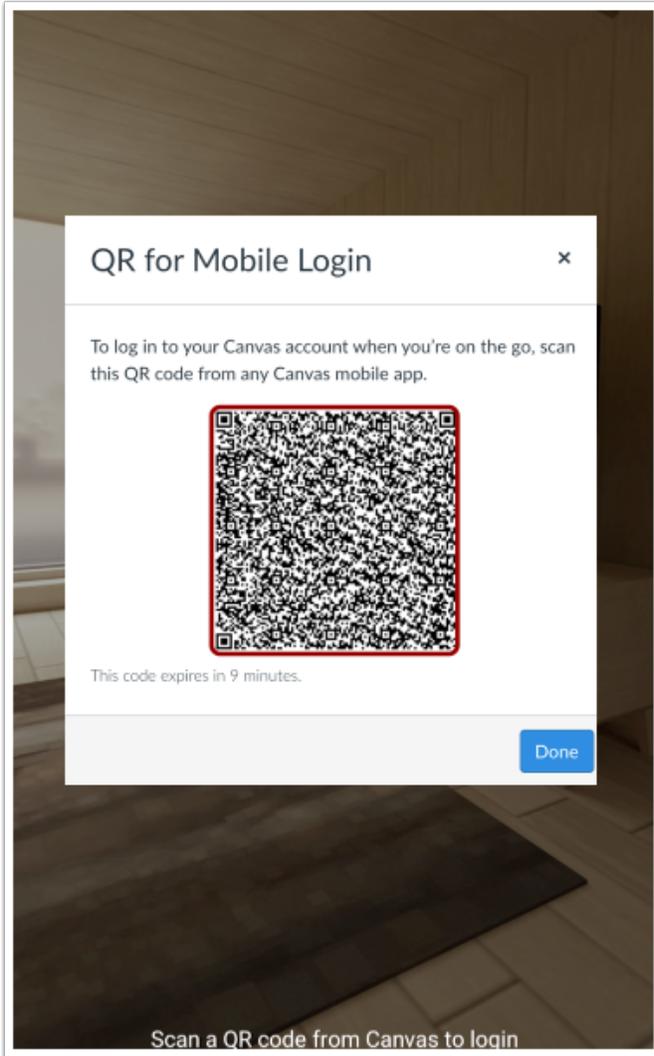
2. Open QR Code



3. Tap the **QR Code** link and view Instructions



4. Review the instructions for locating the QR code in the web version of Canvas. The QR code is located in your account profile (User Navigation Menu).
5. When you have located the QR code, click the **Next** button.
6. Scan QR Code



7. Hold your phone up to your computer screen to scan the QR code. Once the code is located, the app will update automatically.

**Notes:**

- You may have to grant permission for your phone to use your camera.
- The app may take a few minutes to log you in.

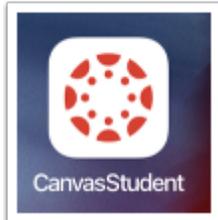

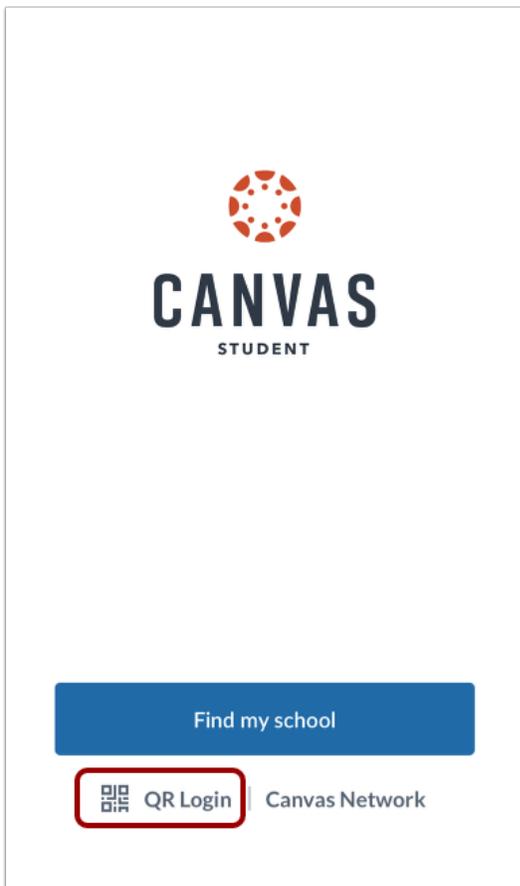
## How to for Apple Phone

Once you download the Canvas Student app from the iTunes store, you can use the app to log in to your Canvas account.

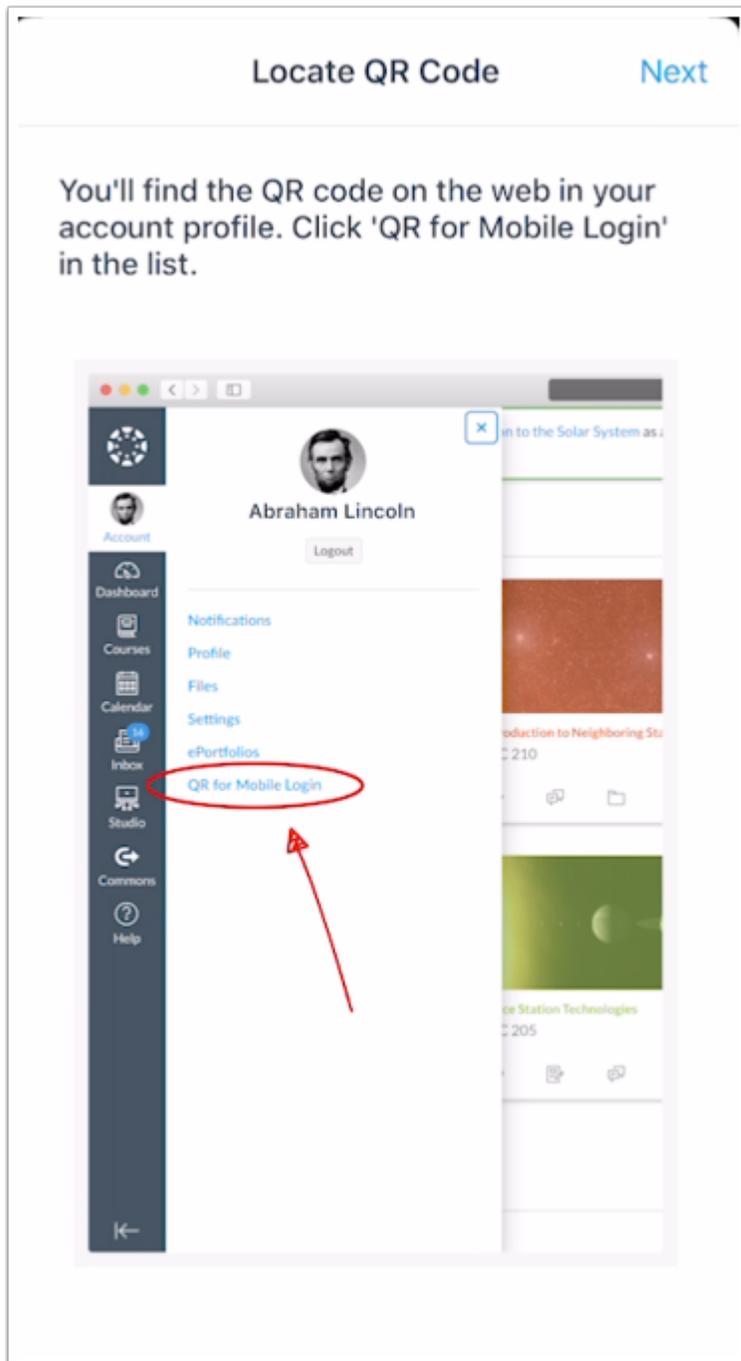
1. Open your Apple device and tap the **Canvas Student** icon.



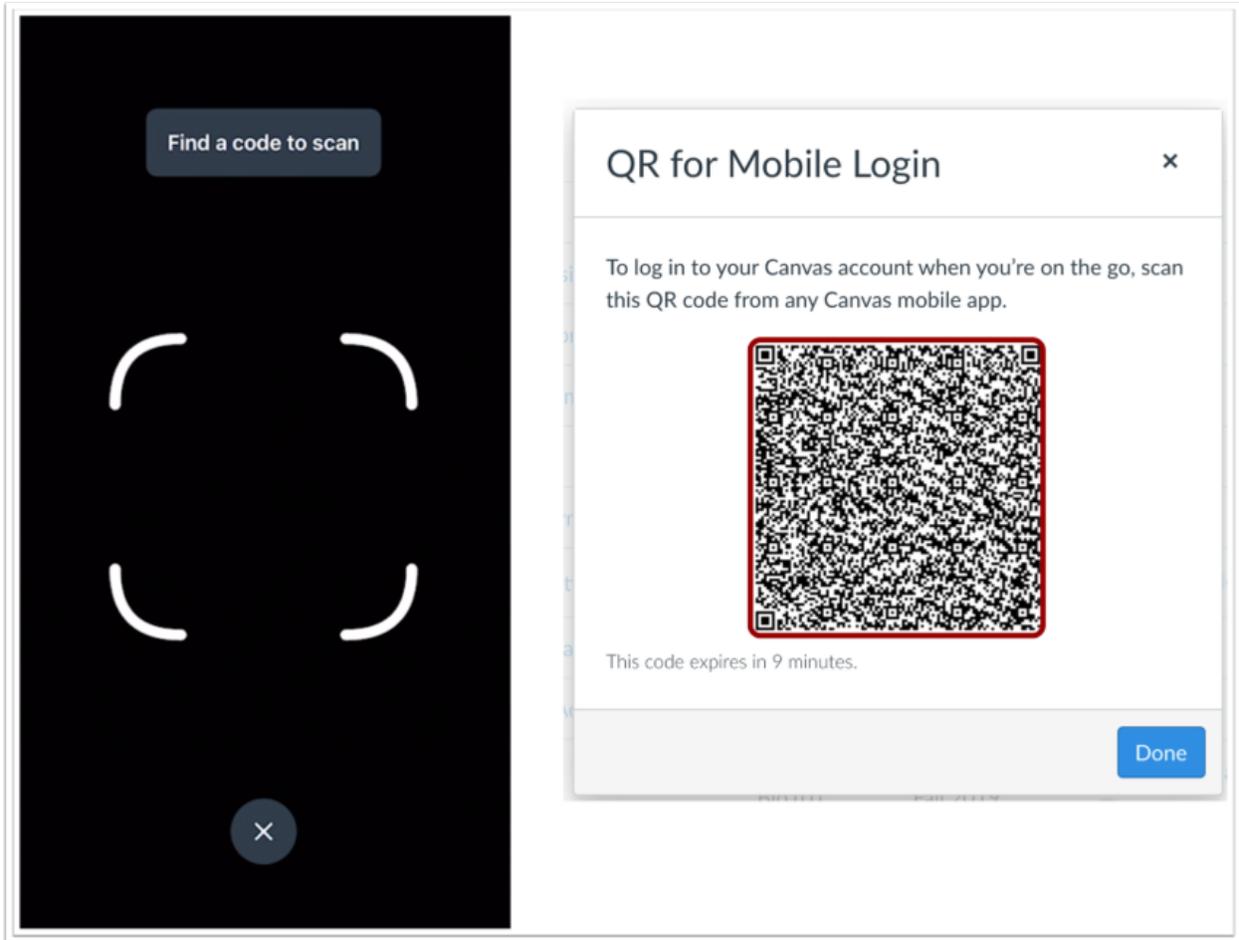
2. Open QR Login
