ACADEMIC SUSPENSION

Students who were Academically Suspended may apply for readmission to the College after a period of at least one semester. The student must submit all transcripts from institutions attended since leaving Eureka College.

ACADEMIC DISMISSAL

Students who are Academically Dismissed from the College *may reapply after a period of at least two academic semesters.*

Students submitting an Application for Readmission who were Academically Dismissed must include the following which will be evaluated by the Academic Standards and Policies Committee to determine whether the student will be readmitted or not:

1. Personal Statement
2. Letter of Recommendation
3. Transcripts from all colleges attended since leaving Eureka College
4. Any other pertinent information
