- ENG095W or an ACT score of 21 is a required prerequisite of ENG103W.
- Courses previously taken for general education requirements that do not transfer into the new program will still apply as major, minor, or elective credit.
- Students entering in 2017-2018 should be encouraged to focus on courses that will transfer into the new program.
